

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER UNIVERSITY **SOUTH EASTERN EUROPE 2013** (ISU SEE 2013)

The ISU SEE is a three week program taking place in the coastal area of Montenegro in cooperation between WU and its Central and South Eastern European partner universities. The academic program focuses on the topic of "European integration in South Eastern Europe from a business perspective" and will be offered by lecturers of WU. The summer university aims at enriching participating students' academic knowledge on the topic and at the same time expanding their intercultural competence.

Budva, Montenegro

Course Outline:

The ISU SEE 2013 will consist of two courses with connected content to be held within three weeks. The first course is designed to transfer the foundations and theoretical background as well as the contextual surroundings of international business in a more integrated Europe to the participants. In the second course, students are expected to apply the knowledge and competence gained in the first course to a specific case in order to gather a deeper understanding of the topic.

Attendance is vitally important for successful completion of each course. Attendance, therefore, is obligatory throughout the whole program (lectures, group works, presentations). Students absent from any part of the program without leave will not be awarded a certificate.

The language of instruction is English. A teambuilding seminar will be organized at the beginning of the program.
