

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHOR(S)

The Journal of Economy and Business of the Faculty of Economics University of Mostar published unpublished manuscripts categorized as: original scientific manuscript, preliminary communication, scientific review manuscript, presentation as a scientific conference, professional manuscript and reviews. The Journal is edited by international Editorial Board and the Journal is cited in EBSCO, CEEOL, Crossref and Hrčak.

The Journal of Economy and Business of the Faculty of Economics University of Mostar **aims** to publish manuscripts within the following economic areas:

- economics
- business and management
- finance
- accounting
- marketing

The Journal is intended for a professional audience (economists, researchers, analysts, consultants), the business community and the broader interested public.

The Journal of Economy and Business of the Faculty of Economics University of Mostar is published once a year in Croatian and English language. A second issue is published annually in special cases and it is related to narrower thematic areas or selected manuscripts from a conference organized by the Faculty of Economics University of Mostar as publisher.

Manuscripts for the Journal of Economy and Business are accepted and published free of charge. Access to all content is free and open to the public. Users may read, store, copy, distribute, print and search full texts articles in this journal without any prior permission from the publisher or author.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Manuscripts are written in Croatian and English, with each manuscript written in Croatian having a title, abstract and keywords in English. Manuscripts written in English must have title, abstract and keywords in Croatian. The Editorial Board will ensure the translation of the title, abstract and keywords in manuscripts by author(s) who do not speak Croatian. The Editorial Board is responsible for the final decision on the publication of received manuscripts in the Journal. The Editorial Board makes decision based on the assessed significance, originality and opinions of at least two reviewers. Manuscripts are subject to objective, double-blind, anonymous peer review. The Editorial Board publishes guidelines for writing manuscripts, that are updated regularly.

Each submitted manuscript first undergoes an assessment of the compliance with the goals of the Journal and technical, grammatical and linguistic instructions. The originality of the manuscript is checked using the Turnitin originality checking system. Author(s) are required to address any use of artificial intelligence (AI) in

the preparation and writing of the manuscript. For each received manuscript, records are kept for the date of receipt by the Editorial Board, date of receipt of manuscript after review requests and date of acceptance of the manuscript for publication.

Manuscripts received for publication in the Journal after consideration by the Editorial Board are sent for double anonymous review, of which at least one is a foreign review. Reviewers provide necessary recommendations according to which the reviewed manuscript will be accepted without changes, returned to the author(s) for correction according to reviewers' instructions or rejected. Based on the reviews, the Editorial Board makes a decision on publication of the manuscript and informs the author(s) thereof within 3 months of receipt of the paper.

Author(s) of the manuscripts retain copyright. The published reserves the right to publish the manuscript (for the first time) and disseminate the published content and data for indexing purposes. Author(s) may publish and archive the paper on their personal websites, social networks and institutional or thematic repositories. Author(s) are required to publish a full bibliographic reference of the journal and include the DOI number. The metadata of the Journal are freely available and may be used under the terms of the Creative Commons license.

Plagiarism includes complete copying (word-to-word) or intentional paraphrasing of parts of other people's works without clear source citation or marking of the copied part (quotation marks), copying equations, figures or tables from other people's works without proper source citation and/or without permission of the original author(s) or copyright holder. Any paper with clear signs of plagiarism will be automatically rejected. In the case when plagiarism is discovered in a paper that has been already published in the Journal, it will be withdrawn in accordance with the withdrawal policy. The Journal implement the withdrawal policy in accordance with COPE standards.

In the case when submitted paper is result of a research project or its earlier/previous version is presented orally at the conference (under the same or similar title), detailed information on project, conference etc. must be mentioned at the beginning of the paper in the footnote. If the paper is result of funded project, author(s) are obliged to indicate the source of funding according to the funding agreement.

The views expressed in the published papers do not express the views of the Editor-in-Chief or the Editorial Board. The author(s) assume legal and moral responsibility for the ideas expressed in the papers. The publisher shall have no liability whatsoever.
