What is it?

Rotman European Trading Competition, the quantitative-finance competition "born from a rib" of the Rotman International Trading Competition, the world's largest simulated market challenge, held annually in Toronto, one of North America's largest financial centres.

2021 "online edition" is a remote electronic trading competition that you can consider as a step towards the Rotman International Trading Competition.

When?

The competition will be held on **Friday August 27th 2021, from 2:00 pm to 8:00** pm (Continental Europe Time | CET).

How many teams can participate from each school?

Organizers are pleased to accept the registration of up to 52 teams, with more than 1 team per European School.

Is the competition for postgraduate students or for undergraduate students?

A school can send a team that consists of either MSc/MBA students or undergraduate students, including those who grad- uated recently. Ph.D. students are also allowed.

How many students make up each team?

There are 4 students per team (equally divided by gender), plus an optional team advisor (faculty, staff, club head).

How does registration work?

To reserve a spot, please fill out the online 'RETC 2021 - Team Registration Form' (Step 1 of the registration process); https://retc.luiss.it/

The form should be filled out by a faculty/staff member or a student. Registration is on a "first-come first-serve basis", so please fill out the 'RETC 2021 - Team Registration Form' as soon as possible. Shortly after, a confirmation will be sent out and the school will appear on the teams page.

The second step of the registration process (Step 2) is the 'Team Member Profile Form'. https://retc.luiss.it/

RETC will compile a participant booklet, which will be available to all competitors, faculty and sponsors. Team member profiles will help identify teams for networking opportunities with students and sponsors that have similar interest. Participation in the competition is **free of charge**.

Registration is open until July 27th 2021 or until 52 teams are registered, whichever comes first.
