

It has passed twenty years since the first assistance from the Government of Japan was delivered to Bosnia and Herzegovina, after the sign of the Dayton Peace Accords in December 1995. As the conflict left tremendous challenges to the country for recovery, continuous support and strong partnership was desperately in need. Japan's Official Development Assistance (ODA) to Bosnia and Herzegovina was firstly focused on the reconstruction of socio-economic infrastructure and improvement of the Basic Human Needs in the health and education sectors, and then the character of assistance gradually developed to a soft-type cooperation such as capacity building of various institutions, private sector development and environmental protection. The concept of peace building and peace consolidation is always inwrought in the JICA's activities. Japan's neutral position towards all ethnic groups is the main source of the mutual trust and partnership. Projects based on a regional approach are opening new opportunities in the Western Balkan region. Japan, as a partner to Bosnia and Herzegovina, will continue to support development of the country on its path to integration to the European Union.


Abenomics

- Two decades of economic stagnation in Japan
- In 2013, Prime Minister Abe launched a comprehensive economic policy package (Abenomics) to sustainably revive the economy of Japan
- Three characteristics:
 - Aggressive monetary policy
 - Flexible fiscal policy
 - Growth strategy including structural reform
- During the last 4 years, Abenomics has achieved remarkable progress
